1. **Practice writing first names of friends, toys, and relatives.** Your child may need to trace the letters of these names at first. Be sure to write in large print letters.

2. **When reading stories to your child,** let them make up the ending, or retell favorite stories with “silly” new endings that they make up.

3. **Play mystery sock.** Put a common household item in a sock. Tie off the top of the sock. Have your child feel the sock and guess what is inside. Take turns guessing what’s inside.



4. **Play the “memory” game.** Put five or six familiar objects on a table. Have your child close their eyes. Remove one object and rearrange the rest. Ask your child which object is missing. Take turns finding the missing object.
