



ASQ Materials List

The Materials List specifies toys and other materials needed to complete the ASQ by ASQ interval. Each questionnaire interval is listed across the top; necessary materials are listed in the far left column. Under each questionnaire interval, a “ dot” indicates a particular item or prop is needed to complete the ASQ. Most items listed are portable and can be found in the home or child care settings. There are a few items (e.g., steps; chair; stroller, shopping cart, or wagon) that may not be easily available. For these particular items, other objects may be substituted to demonstrate the intended skill.

Most of the items listed are likely to be found in a family home (i.e., cup, clothing), but it may be helpful to check with the family to see if materials are easily available to them or if assistance may be needed.

Use the list below to check for toys, objects or materials that may need to be gathered before completing and submitting an ASQ online.

- Page 2 is a short inventory list.
- Page 3 shows items or props needed by ASQ interval.

ASQ3 Materials Inventory List

This list can also be used as a reference for the kinds of things to have on hand when parents try activities with a child. The list covers materials across all age intervals of ASQ.

- ***Reminder: Whenever possible, it is better to use materials that a family has in their home and that a child has had opportunities to play with.***

You may also make your own substitutions as described elsewhere in *The ASQ User's Guide* (Squire, Potter, & Bricker, 1999).

Alphabetical list of items

- Baby bottle (clear)
- Ball: large (with hand pump to inflate; ball may be stored deflated when not being used)
- Ball: small
- Beads: small, to string (xx included)
- Book: wordless picture book • Book: storybook with pictures
- Blocks: small (10 included)
- Bowl
- Coloring book (with tear-out pages)
- Crayons: two sizes (one 4-pack of small; one 3-pack of chunky)
- Cup
- Fork (child size)
- Jars: clear plastic with screw lid, one short and one tall (short one may be used for “jar with screw lid” or “wind-up toy”; tall one may be used for “clear bottle” if baby bottle is not used)
- Mirror
- Puzzle (6-piece, interlocking)
- Scissors (child-safe)
- Shoelace (may be used for “string”)
- Spoon (child size) (may be used for “stick”)
- Stuffed animal with buttons and zipper (may be used for “doll”)
- Toy: keys on chain (may be used for “small toy” or “rattle”)
- Toy: small, easy to grasp
