



## Instructions for Parents to Complete Questionnaires Online

### Instructions

#### 1. Please go to [asqoregon.com](http://asqoregon.com)

- Complete an ASQ to check your child's development

Note - The online session will remain open as long as your browser setting allows.

#### 2. Download, review and share your child's ASQ and Results Letter

- Download and print the PDF of completed ASQ and/or ASQ:SE
- Download and print Results Letter from the last page online and/or from your email
- Share copies of ASQ and Results letter with your child's care provider or teacher

### Important Tips

#### Keep these tips in mind when you complete the ASQ:

- Take time to observe or try each item with your child
- Your child may be able to do some but not all of the items asked
- You or family members can help your child practice skills

### Questions in the ASQ ask about skills in five areas, or "domains"

**Communication** - Looks at your child's language skills, what he or she understands and what he or she can say

**Gross motor** - Looks at your child's large muscle movement and coordination

**Fine motor** - Looks at your child's hand and finger movement and coordination

**Problem solving** - Looks at how your child plays with toys and solves problems

**Personal-social** - Looks at your child's self-help skills and interactions with others

**Overall Section** - Asks important questions about your child's overall development and any concerns you may have

### Answers: Choose the response that best describes your child

- **Yes** means your child is able to do the skill
- **Sometimes** means your child is just beginning to do the skill but only does it sometimes
- **Not yet** means your child can not yet do the skill
