



REVIEW STEPS

Complete following steps to check for accuracy of ASQ:SE results prior to making follow-up decisions with parents.

___ **1. Check child's age compared to ASQ:SE age range “window”***

- Was child's age calculated & correct ASQ:SE administered?*
- Was age adjusted for prematurity (for children under 2 years)?
- Is child's age at the young or older end of ASQ:SE “window”?

___ **2. Review parent concerns (Items that score 10 or 15 points)**

- Ask parent, “*can you tell me more about...*”; take notes
- Review 10-point items, with no concerns. *Why isn't caregiver concerned? Was item misunderstood? Are there culture/parenting differences?*

___ **3. Review omitted items**

- Discuss item with parent. If appropriate, mark a response.
- **Adjust area total** if items need to be omitted because of parenting practices/beliefs/customs*

___ **4. Review and discuss ASQ:SE Overall Section**

- What are responses to overall section?
- What are parent concerns?
- What are provider concerns?

___ **5. Consider factors that may impact results** (see pages 98-103 ASQ:SE-2 User's Guide)

- Time/Setting
- Health
- Development
- Family
