How to use the Oregon Screening Project site - Letter to Parent

(sample instructions from provider to parent)

Dear Parent

Thanks for participating in our early developmental screening program.

We are asking you to fill out an ASQ and an ASQ:SE for your child in this free online public service site, and then share or send results to your child's teacher. No names or personal information are needed to use this site. We will schedule a time to review your ASQ and ASQ:SE together in_____.

- The ASQ asks about skills and behaviors that children do at each age.
- Your child may be able to do some but not all of the activities asked.
- Because the ASQ looks at your child's strengths and how well your child is doing, it's important to try an activity with your child if you're not sure whether you have seen them do the skill.

ASQ Response options

Be sure to try an activity if you haven't already seen your child do a skill

- Yes - your child has already done the skill or activity - or is doing it at this time.
- Sometimes - you are just beginning to see the skill.
- Not Yet - your child isn't doing the skill at this time.

Questions in the ASQ ask about skill in 5 areas of development

- **Communication** - language skills, what they understand and what they can say.
- **Gross Motor** - looks at your child's movement and coordination.
- **Fine Motor** - looks at your child's hand and finger movement and coordination.
- **Problem Solving** - looks at how your child plays with things and how they think.
- **Personal Social** - looks at your child's self-help skill and how they engage with people.

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How to Fill out ASQ Online



Steps to use the Oregon Screening Project site

You can leave the session open for 24 hours if your own security allows this. For security reasons, your place in the session is lost if you leave or close.

1. Go to <https://osp.uoregon.edu>
2. Click Get Started
3. At the Download or Continue online page, click Continue to fill out the ASQ online
4. After your ASQ you will see option to Complete or Skip the ASQ:SE.
Please continue to fill out the ASQ:SE.
5. At the Get My Results page, please enter your email so you will receive your copies of questionnaires and results letters in an email.
6. Continue to the last page and use the links to view/download your ASQ, ASQSE and Results letters.

To Preview the ASQ before entering responses online

Look through the ASQ for your child's age and try activities together if needed, before answering online.

To get a blank ASQ (view or print) follow steps 1,2,3, above, then:

- Select Download a blank instead of Continue to online.
- Print or view the ASQ and see if there are any activities that you might need to try.
- Then return to the online site when you're ready and follow steps to fill out the ASQ online.



Steps to Share ASQ, ASQSE and Results with your child's teacher

1. When you get your child's results in email, please choose "Forward", enter your teacher's email _____ and send.
2. Because no names appear on your questionnaires or results letters, you may need to add your name in body of the email so the teacher can easily identify your child.
